(4) Including the health expenditures of central government, revolving funds, extra-budgetary funds, social security institutions, local administrations and SEEs. The whole budget of Ministry of Health (including green card expenditures) is taken into account in the health expenditures of the central government. For the other central government institutions' and local administrations' health expenditures, amounts in the health function code in their budgets and health expenditures of these institutions' personnel which is paid by their institutions are taken into account. In order to avoid duplication, special provincial administrations' investments which are financed by transfers from Ministry of Health are not included. Transfers to the Ministry of Environment and City Planning and Housing Development Administration are included in the health investments of the Ministry of Health. In the calculation of Social Security Institution's health expenditures, payments to the health service providers and copayments collected by the health service providers are taken into account.

(5) Including pension payments (additional payments excluded) and other expenditures of social security institutions and expenditures of Unemployment Insurance Fund excluding payments used for GAP Action Plan and other social and economic development investments. State contribution to the Unemployment Insurance Fund is not included.
